The reality in Guatemala is even harsher: communities that struggle in normal times are buckling under the weight of job loss and pandemic restrictions. Public programs are shut down, available work is scarce, and families are starving. In the face of community needs, SewHope abruptly shifted gears to provide emergency food aid to the most vulnerable in our community.

But the Spirit prevails – both human and Holy. In the pages of our annual report you will find nostalgia, anticipation, and humanity. #### 2019: BY THE NUMBERS

- 1,390 women were screened for cervical cancer
- Over 88 women were treated for pre-cancerous lesions
- 3 medical mission trips brought U.S. doctors and medical students to northern Guatemala
- **5** training events were held with local nurses to improve pap smear techniques
- 2 cytotechs from the U.S. visited to train local cytotechs in preparing and reading pap smear slides

- \*R\* espect each process of teaching in order to achieve the best academic outcomes."








## 2019: BY THE NUMBERS


- 111 children attended our supplementary education program
- 1 new fiber optic internet line was installed
- 12 local partner schools received supplemental school meals through our partnership with Kids Against Hunger
- >40 area children were seen by American pediatrician Dr. Jacob Snow in November

In September 2019, architect Jonathan (left) and contractor Camilo (right) met on-site to plan the building project.







#### 2019: BY THE NUMBERS

- >21 varieties of fruits and vegetables were grown on 1.5
   acres of land
- 25 children and 7 women raised 400 chickens to sell and eat
- 8 safer, cleaner-burning stoves were installed in area homes
- 1 new community received a commercial-grade water filter; maintenance continued on previously-installed water filters in 5 nearby communities
- 2 new fish ponds provided a home for **several hundred** tilapia (which were eventually harvested and eaten)

For me the favorite part of my job that I do at SewHope is planting vegetables. I like it very much. I thank you very much for the opportunity you have given me to be able to work for SewHope.




